Solarize Philly helps all Philadelphians go solar.

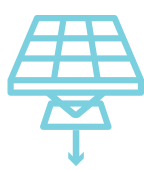
- Solarize Philly remains the nation’s largest single solarize initiative.
- The number of contracts signed in 2019 was nearly doubled any prior year. With 294 contracts signed Phase 3 was the strongest phase of the program to-date
- Solarize Philly maintained momentum despite COVID-19 in 2020. 54 additional households signed solar contracts in Phase 4, with the support of all-virtual Solarize Philly programming and remote sales visits conducted by Solar States.
- PEA supported 50 low- and moderate-income households to go solar in Phase 4 through the Solar Savings Grant Program. There was no credit requirement and no upfront cost for participation, with savings starting in Year 1.
- Philadelphia City Council established Philadelphia Solar Week as the third week in August, inspired by Solarize Philly. Solar Week 2020 reached 2,500 viewers.
- More than 150 Philadelphians participated in Solar Home Tours in 2019 (in-person) and 250 in 2020 (virtually). This citywide event creates a platform for the solar-curious to learn from the experiences of their neighbors who have adopted rooftop solar.
- Philadelphia launched Pennsylvania’s first high school vocational solar program, the first program of its kind in the nation. The new Bright Solar Futures program kicked off with the first class of 10th grade students at Frankford High School in Fall 2020. The Philadelphia Energy Authority and partners support the program funded by the U.S. Department of Energy and PECO.

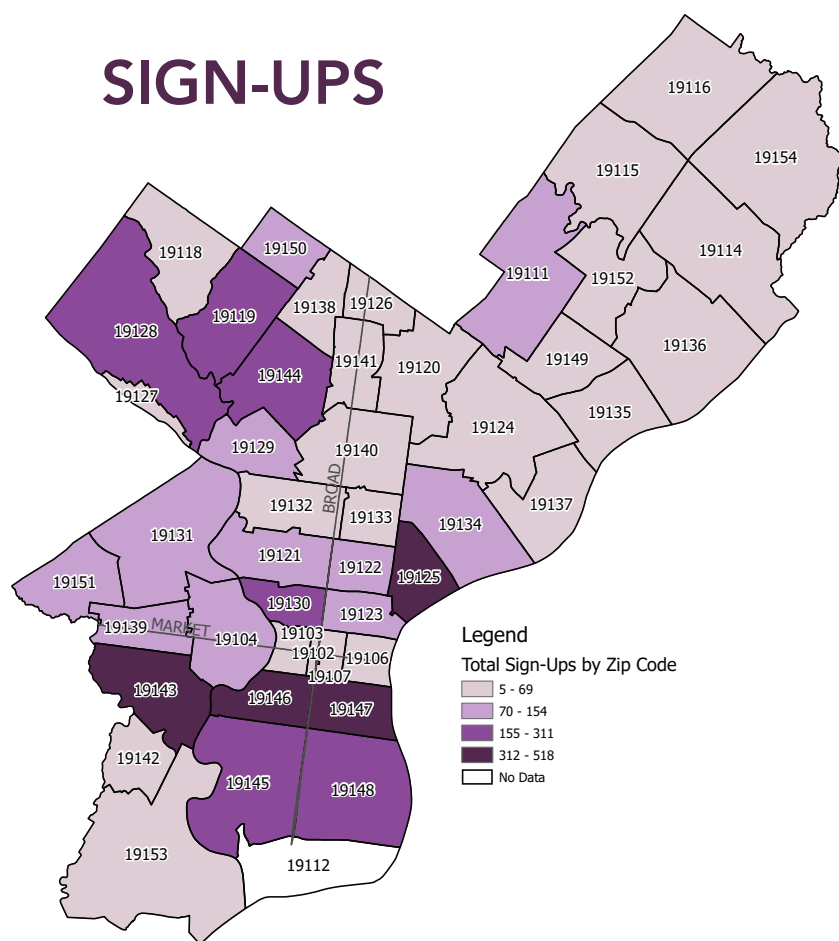

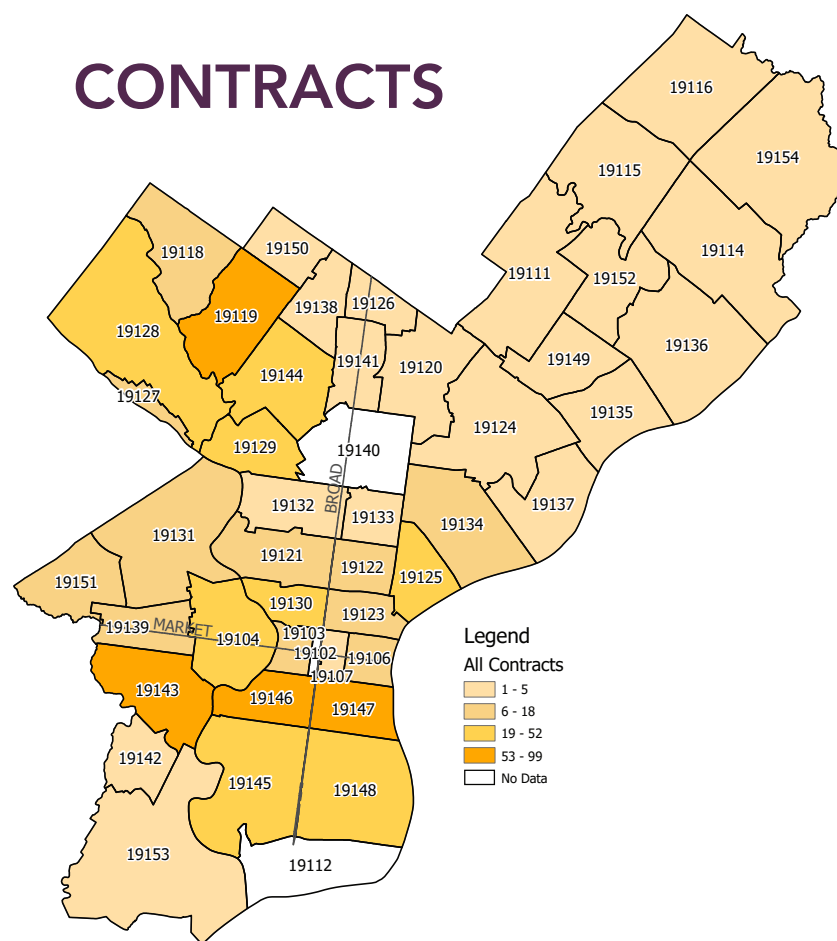
